- A note from our counselor, Mrs. Mulholland to our 8th graders:

 Please be aware that any offers not accepted by the deadline will be automatically declined. This action is irreversible, and students who have not

accepted an offer will need to participate in the rolling waitlist to be considered for non-neighborhood programs. I want to emphasize that accepting an offer does not affect a student's waitlist status for other programs. In light of this, we strongly advise all students to accept their initial offer. This ensures that you secure a spot in a high school program while still allowing you the opportunity to remain on the waitlist for other programs that may be of interest to you."

- IAR (Illinois Assessment of Readiness) testing for students in grades 3-8 will be held at Solomon on March 12-14, with make-up testing the following week. The IAR is our state-mandated assessment for all students that do not qualify for any alternative assessments, and we have used results to identify areas for instructional improvement school-wide.
