- Additionally, our next <u>Tot Time</u> for new and prospective Pre-K families in room 108 will be June 1 from 4:30-5:30.
- Our main office is open daily for registration between 9:30-3:30 each day through June 9, and our summer registration hours will be released shortly.
- As I shared last week, I am happy to announce that the YMCA of Chicago will be providing both before-school and after-school childcare for Solomon students in the 2023-2024 school year. To register for next year's programming, please follow the directions in this link. This past year our morning program did fill up to capacity, and there was a waitlist, so I recommend registering sooner rather than later if you are going to require that programming. We will supplement this fee-based program with some Solomon-staffed options, starting in September or October, as well.
- The Albany Park branch (3401 W. Foster) of the Chicago Public Library is asking all children to take part in our <u>summer program</u>. Kids can sign up at their local library or online starting June 10. When they come into the library, they will get an Explorer's Guide with activities for them to do and a log to keep track of their reading. All kids who complete 500 minutes, Do 5 activities, and reflect on them will earn a t-shirt (while supplies last).
